The International Adoption Center (IAC) at Cincinnati Children's exists to meet the health and wellness needs of internationally adopted children, their families and their communities. The staff in the IAC addresses the complex medical, developmental and psychological challenges that many internationally adopted children face, while also providing support for their forever families.

Since 1999, the IAC has assisted more than 3,000 adoptive families from 48 states welcome children into their homes. We are internationally recognized as a resource for both pre- and post-adoption services and education for families. There are fewer than 10 centers in the United States that offer specialized care to internationally adopted children, and none are as comprehensive as our program at Cincinnati Children's.

The IAC Needs Your Help


As a nonprofit hospital and research center, Cincinnati Children's relies on the partnership of donors to help fund important services like those provided by the IAC.
